Technique: Piecing, Applique

- Background: 4 yards Riley White

- Suggested tool: Lori Holt 8" Pie Ruler
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)



Scaredy Cat Christmas

Description:

Come have some feline fun! The Scaredy Cat Christmas quilt is sure to bring you some Christmas Cheer. Learn how to make the 3 different blocks (cat, star, and tree) and put them together in this fun off-set way! The quilt measures 66" x 79".

Technique: Piecing

Skill Level: Intermediate

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- 36 10" squares for blocks
- 1 1/4 yard border fabric
- 4 yards holly fabric
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)



I Can't Believe It's Machine Applique

with Carmen Geddes

Description:

Enjoy beautiful, instant success in applique that will look hand done! If you have ever been overwhelmed by an applique project or have always wanted to try but were unsure about the handwork, then this class is for you. Create a beautiful 18" block. Pattern included for a mini quilt or table topper. You will get so hooked on this technique that you will want to create enough for a whole quilt! Plus, get a bonus demo on bias vines!

Technique: Machine Applique

Skill Level: Beginner

Class Fee: \$69

Kit Fee: \$15

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Regular sewing foot (not 1/4")
- Fabric: 1/2 yard light colored cotton for background
- Selection of small pieces (fat quarters work well) of assorted fabrics for applique. The sample we will work on will be a floral motif - so choose colors for the main flower, stems, leaves, etc.
- Small travel iron if you own one (there will be some irons to share)
- Small ironing surface- you will want one close to your machine (there will be a few to share)
- Marking pencil or pen (air or water-soluble works great)
- Pencil for Tracing
- 3-4 Elmer's Washable Glue Sticks or Sewline glue pen (I prefer white)
- Sewing thread to match background fabric - like Clear Mono-filament Thread - Sulky or Superior (Available to purchase in class)
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)



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Crossing Paths

Description:

Crossing Paths is a delightful quilt with wonderful geometric blocks that make a bold statement and create some amazing secondary designs. This quilt is fat quarter friendly, so it's easy to pick a bundle or grab from your stash. Learn no-waste flying geese, stitch and flip corners, and many other great tips to help you line up all those points to perfection. There are lots of size options, so you can make the project that is perfectly sized for you. Whatever size you choose, you are sure to finish with an absolutely stunning quilt!

Finished Project Size: The Crossing Paths pattern offers 5 sizes: Baby size (measures 44" x 44", comprised of 4 blocks), Lap size (measures 63" x 82", comprised of 12 blocks), Picnic size (measures 82" x 82", comprised of 16 blocks), Twin size (measures 82" x 101", comprised of 20 blocks), and Queen/King size (measures 101" x 101", comprised of 25 blocks)

The Harvest Home quilt is 58" square, with two rows of pieced houses and an appliqued center block featuring branches filled with leaves and fruits. In this class, we will learn piecing techniques and Jill's applique method to create perfect bias stems and turned-edge applique.

The pattern includes five pumpkin sizes to fit all your fall decorating needs. Learn how to sew, stuff, and finish your own fabulous pumpkins!

Technique: Curve sewing, 3-D Projects, Ladder Stitch

Learn tips and tricks for fussy cutting and join Jennifer Long and fellow classmates as you sew together the "Greatest Gift!"

Enjoy creating large and small Summer Stars blocks while learning incredible skills on color placement so that each one is unique. Students should cut fabrics prior to class. This class is great for beginner students who want to learn some essential quilting skills.

Technique: Piecing

Skill Level: Beginner

Class Fee: \$69

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Self-healing mat
- 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" (or bigger) rectangular acrylic ruler
- Assorted bright print fabrics and white background fabric (both cut prior to class according to pattern instructions),
- Coordinating thread for machine
- 9-1/2" (or bigger) square acrylic ruler will be needed for class.
- Please note that you will probably only make 2-3 large blocks and 2-3 small blocks during class.

Students will gather to create a quilt made of 2 1/2" strips and 3 1/2" blocks of simple sawtooth stars. So, gather your reds, whites, and blues and come sew for a few hours with Paula!

Technique: Piecing

Skill Level: Beginner

- Sewing machine
- The strips: you need a variety of red, white & blue 2 1/2" strips - 136 strips 2 1/2" x 9 1/2"
- The squares: you need a variety of red, white & blue 3 1/2" squares - 36 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares
- The simple sawtooth star: 1/8 yard of 7-8 assorted blues
- 1/3 yard of background fabric
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)



Jelly Roll Magic

with Carmen Geddes

Description:

Come learn beginner techniques to make a stunning vintage quilt! We will use the EasyPiecing technique without any strip sewing required. You'll need two jelly rolls and background fabric to get started. Use the EasyPiecing Grid to make your heirloom. Quilt measures 78" x 78" before border, or you can make two lap-size quilts instead.

Technique: Piecing, EasyPiecing foundation piecing

Skill Level: Beginner

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- 1/4" piecing foot
- 6 Elmer's washable school glue sticks or Sewline glue pens (recommended white that dries clear).
- Two rolls of 2.5" strips(40 strips per roll) (precut fabric to 2.5" squares)

- 13 panels EasyPiecing Grid-2" finished (provided in class)
- Optional: Applique pressing sheet
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)



How They Shine

Description:

How They Shine is all about creating beautiful star blocks. One block is set in alternate fabric layouts to create a beautiful design that highlights several secondary designs. With one fabric per block, you can really show off some of your favorite prints. This quilt is fat quarter friendly, so it's easy to pick a bundle or grab from your stash. Come learn half-square triangles, stitch and flip corners, Nested Angled Seams, and many other great tips to help you line up those points to perfection. There are lots of size options for you to choose the right sized project that works for you. Whatever size you choose, you are sure to finish with a great quilt.

Finished Project Size: The How They Shine pattern offers 5 sizes: Baby size (measures 48" x 48", comprised of 9 blocks), Lap size (measures 48" x 64", comprised of 12 blocks), Twin size (measures 64" x 80", comprised of 20 blocks), Picnic size (measures 80" x 80" and is comprised of 25 blocks), and Queen size (measures 96" x 96", comprised of 36 blocks).

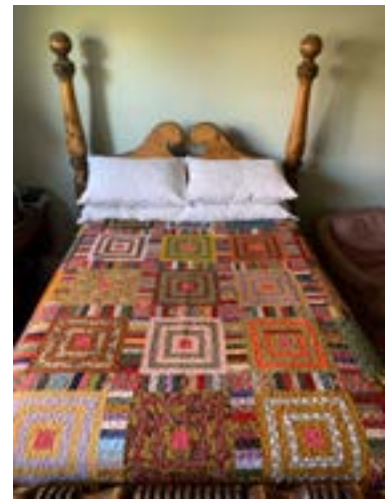

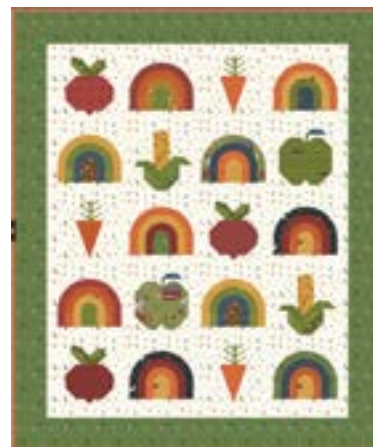

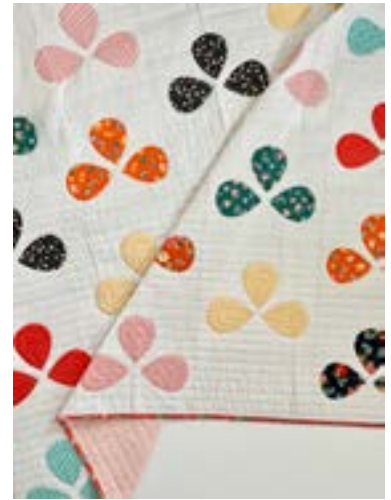

Dahlias

This method creates two blocks of the same coloring at the same time with opposite rotations/mirror images. The rows are also assembled in vertical rows. Different colors change the appearance of the flower: when using yellow it looks like a sunflower, but change the coloring to red and it looks like a poinsettia!
