Carve out some time to make this gourd-geous pumpkin and autumn leaves quilt! Misty will provide the instructions needed for sewing the quilt with a finished size of 70" x 80", just right for snuggling under on chilly nights.

Strawberry Basket Quilt

Description:

Stitch a fresh throw-quilt featuring delicious strawberries. This quilt has a secret in assembly -- the quilt's two blocks are set on-point to create a chain with little Xs as a secondary design. In this class, you'll make at least one of each block. You'll learn tips for sewing stitch-and-flip units, strip piecing, and working with small pieces to create a gorgeous (and traditionally-pieced) quilt. The featured fabrics are from the To Grandmother's House fabric collection by Jennifer Long for Riley Blake Designs.



Suncatcher

Description:

Suncatcher is a foundation paper pieced design by Quiltworx. Foundation paper piecing, floating points, Template Layout Sheets, and curved paper piecing techniques for attaching the curved sashing are all featured in these instructions. After the paper piecing is completed, traditional curved piecing is required to assemble the blocks. This quilt is fun to make and easily adapted to using strips and background fabric from your own stash if you like.

Technique: Piecing

Finished Project Size: 30"x30"

- Sewing machine with 1/4" foot (no guard)

- Background for Corner geese - 12"

Learn tips and techniques for precision piecing to create a beautiful medallion quilt.

Technique: Piecing

Finished Project Size: 72.5"x72.5"

Skill Level: Intermediate

Class Fee: \$149 Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine

- Basic sewing supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)

Fabric

- 1 fat eight bundle (containing at least 32 pieces)

- 1 fat eighth for center block (shown in blue)

- 1 fat eighth for center block (shown in red)

- Background (center block, blocks, borders): 3 7/8 yards

Make a miniature like a PRO with EasyPiecing Grid! Cut ONE INCH squares! This beauty finishes at 18 x 18. You'll be using HALF inch finished EasyPiecing Grid. No pins! Fun, fast, and accurate piecing. Check out tutorials on tensisters.com

Kit Fee: \$30 includes 6 panels EasyPiecing Grid, pattern, step by step instructions.

Supplies: Basic cutting and sewing supplies, 5 Elmer's washable school glue sticks or Sewline glue pens (I prefer the white that dries clear). Applique pressing sheet(optional) There will be irons and cutting mats to share.

Fabric: This can be as scrappy as you like! There are a total of 1227 squares in this project. (don't let that scare you!) I recommend choosing around 12 fabrics and cut 100 squares of each color. *1/8 yard of fabric yields over 165 squares. If you have a favorite fabric you want to use a lot, cut more for class. Bring your extra fabric to class in case you want to cut more.

Description:

Get crafty! The Allover Project Bag class is filled with tips and tricks to help you sew a pretty dumpling-shaped zipper pouch in two sizes!

Technique: Binding, Zipper attachment, Bag assembly, Handle attachment

Finished Project Size: Big Bag: 13"(33cm)W x 8 1/2"(22cm)H x 6 1/2"(16.5cm)D,

Small Bag: 12"(31cm)W x 5 1/2"(14cm)H x 5 1/2"(14cm)D

Skill Level: Intermediate

Class Fee: \$69 Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine with 1/4 foot and walking foot
- Fabric spray adhesive (such as Odif 505)
- Fabric glue such as Roxann Glue-Baste-It or Elmer's washable glue

Learn how to paper piece a striking over-sized Pineapple Block! This is a great block to learn the technique of paper-piecing!

Technique: Foundation, Paper Piecing

Finished Project Size: 74"x74"

Skill Level: Beginner Class Fee: \$69

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Washable glue stick
- Basic sewing supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)

- One square of fabric measuring 2 1/2" (block center)
- Lots of fabric strips in 2 different colors measuring 2" x WOF (width of fabric) or whatever length you can get if using scraps.
- 4 white strips of fabric measuring 2" x WOF





Patsy's Perfect Blooms

Description:

This lovely spring-themed quilt focuses on 3 outer blocks that rotate around the beautiful center medallion starburst. A combination of flowers, leaves and butterflies create the perfect garden get-away. The leaves will enable you to learn a Drunkards Path block, (curved piecing), and a unique way to make a tonal colored leaf. The flowers showcase a basic nine patch centers & stitch and flip outer pieces. The medallion pieces are half square triangles and a 4 patch blocks sewn to create the starburst effect. *photo courtesy of Quiltmaker magazine.

Technique: Piecing, Curved piecing **Finished Project Size:** 55"x55"

Skill Level: Intermediate

Class Fee: \$69

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- 1/4 inch foot for machine
- Starch Spray
- Class pattern (purchase from instructor in class \$11)
- Rotary rulers recommended: 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, & straight ruler (18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or larger)

- Blue Stripe 5/8 yd for binding

Rescued & New Quilt Jackets

Description:

Recycle your favorite old quilt (or a new one!) to create your new favorite jacket. It makes wearing your quilt to the movie theater totally legal.

Technique: Easy clothing construction, Binding

Finished Project Size: One size fits most

Skill Level: Beginner Class Fee: \$69 Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine

- Basic sewing supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a

rotary cutter)



- You will need fabric quilted with top, batting and backing quilted to a twin size bed quilt or larger, or a rescued old quilt same size.
- 155" 11/2" binding, folded wrong sides together and pressed
- 3 yards of new quilted fabric
- 180" 2" binding, folded wrong sides together and pressed

NOTE: I always bind my quilts with 2" binding. Cut the width of the 180" binding the width you like
