Frosty

with Karen Walker

Description:

Frosty is bound to melt your heart! From piecing large pieces to smaller pieces, Karen will share how to piece for success. Learn the Half Rectangle Triangle Method. It's so easy and no special tool is required.

The striped scarf is a breeze using a striped fabric printed on the diagonal. And a bonus tip! Called Cheater Miter! Due to the time constraint of the class time, Karen will demo techniques used in her Frosty quilt and get you sewing right away.

Technique: Corner Triangle Method

- Black: 1/4 yard
- Creamy White: 1/2 yard
- Red: 3/4 yard
- Red Stripe printed on the diagonal: 2/3 yard
- Broom Handle: 1/8 yard
- Broom Bristles: 1/8 yard each of blue and green
- Outer Border: 1-1/4 yards
- Backing: 3 - 1/2 yards



Bindings & Alternate Endings Workshop

Description:

In a bind when it comes to binding a quilt? This class has you covered with practical tips and time-saving tricks to help you finish your quilts with style! We'll start with the basics, mastering mitered corners and demystifying that tricky final seam. Then, we'll get creative with five fun "alternate endings" ~ scallops, prairie points, faux-piping, DIY chenille, curvy edges ~ just a handful of the 16 techniques featured in the "Ultimate Binding & Edge-Finishing Guide". Get ready to tackle your binding challenges, try some creative finishes, and sew with confidence right to the very last stitch!

Technique: Binding and several other creative finishes for quilts and sewn projects

Finished Project Size: 12"x18"

Skill Level: Beginner

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Required Book: "Ultimate Binding & Edge-Finishing Guide for Quilting & Sewing" by Deonn Stott, \$17. Order online at Quiltscapes Etsy Shop, or pick up in class.

Fabric:

- Main Fabric: Use 2 Fat Quarters OR 3/8 yard of fabric cut in half to yield 2 @ x 13 1/2" x 22"). Pre-quilt the fabric by sandwiching the two pieces with a layer of thin batting between. Baste the edges, and quilt as desired. You may also purchase pre-quilted fabric.
- Print A: 1/2 yard coordinating small print, tone on tone print or solid to match the quilted fabric.
- Print B: 1/4 yard contrasting/coordinates SOLID dyed fabric.

Gourdgeous Pumpkin Runner

Description:

This stunning table runner will be a centerpiece in your fall home décor! With three sized pumpkins this lovely quilted project is a fun way to showcase your favorite autumn fabrics.

Techniques:

- Stitch and flip corners
- Accurate piecing
- Free motion quilting basics

Finished Project Size: Table Runner finishes at approximately 42" x 15"

Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Class Fee: \$69

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)

Fabric:

- Pumpkin Fabric - at least 4 fat quarters - 2 coordinating sets of two - 10" fabric squares will also work - you will need 2 coordinating squares per pumpkin
- Stem Fabric: scraps or fat eighth
- Border Fabric: 1/4 yard
- Background Fabric: 1/2 yard
- Backing Fabric: 1 yard
- Binding Fabric: 1/4 yard
- Batting: Cut to 43" x 17"

Daisy Chain is a stunning quilt with a whole new twist on a Chain Quilt!! Beautiful flowers dance across the quilt top with lots of wonderful negative space. Come learn an easy 3 pin method of making Modified Drunkard Path blocks. This is the perfect class if you have been nervous about trying curves, I will show you just how fun piecing curves are!! I promise!! Daisy Chain is Fat Quarter Friendly. By the end, you will have a wonderful quilt to show for it and a new mastered technique. We are going to have a great time!

Technique: No waste flying geese, Half Square triangles, Tricks to get those points to perfection

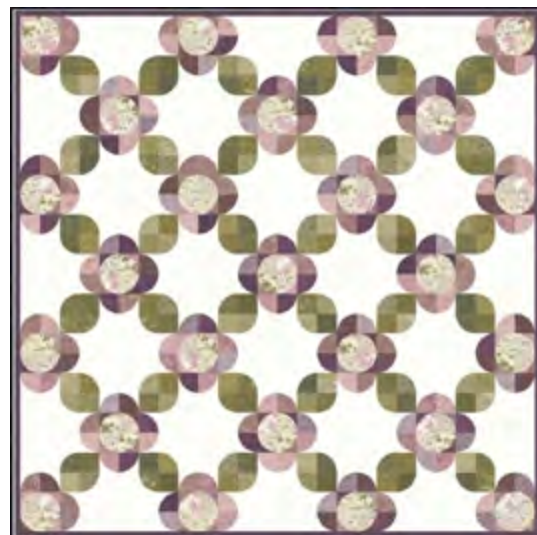

I will give you all my tips and tricks as a AccuQuilt Designer to get a stunning and flawless result when using AccuQuilt to cut your quilts. My go-to picnic dish recipe (Nanny Roy's fried chicken with Gutherie's sauce) is included in the pattern.

Technique: Cutting and accurately piecing with AccuQuilt dies, Traditional piecing with multiple size pieces, Raw-Edge Applique

Finished Project Size: Large Throw Quilt 76" x 76"

Skill Level: Intermediate

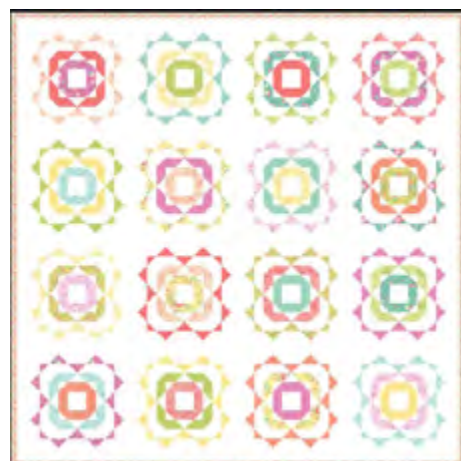

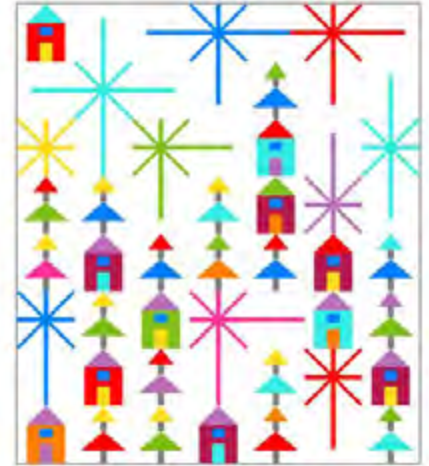

- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)

Fabric:

- 15 fall print fat quarters (Pumpkin & Leaf Blocks)
- 1 green fat quarter (pumpkin leaf)
- 1 brown 10" square or equiv. (pumpkin stem)
- 2/3 yard green accent fabric
- 4 1/4 yards natural linen background fabric
- 2/3 yard binding fabric
- 5 1/4 yards quilt backing

For the background fabric I used Riley Blake natural linen which is a linen/cotton blend

It combines a Primrose Block (the larger floral block) and a Proper Block (the smaller floral block) and offsets both with adorable tiny cornerstone floral blocks. This quilt is Fat Quarter friendly so it's easy to pick a bundle or grab from your Stash, and I recommend adding Low Volumes to the Bloom Center of your Primrose Block, it really makes the flowers pop!! Come learn no-waste flying geese, stitch and flip corners, and the tricks to get all those perfect points. There are lots of size options, so you can make the size project that works just right for you. Whatever size you choose, you are sure to have a finish that is absolutely stunning!!! So come sign up, we are going to have a great time!!!

Technique: No waste flying geese, Stitch and flip corners, Tricks to get the perfect points

Finished Project Size: Offers (6) different sizes. A baby size measures 39" x 38" and is comprised of 4 blocks. A lap size measures 56" x 73" and is comprised of 12 blocks. - A small ruler with 3/8" marking
- A heat-erasable or chalk marking pen
- 80 - 100 weight cottonized-polyester thread for applique in a color that matches the applique pieces
