This quilt is Fat Quarter friendly so it's easy to pick a bundle or grab from your stash. Come learn stitch and flip corners, tips for tiny piecing and the tricks of nested angled seams to get all those perfect points. There are lots of size options, so you can make the size project that works just right for you. Whatever size you choose, you are sure to have a finish that is absolutely stunning! So come sign up, we are going to have a great time!

Technique: Stitch and Flip Corners, Tiny piecing, Nested Angled Seams

Finished Project Size: The Home is Where the Heart is Pattern offers 6 sizes. A baby size measures 47" x 47" and is comprised of 4 blocks. A child size measures 47" x 63" and is comprised of 6 blocks. A lap size measures 63" x 79" and is comprised of 12 blocks. A picnic size measures 79" x 95" and is comprised of 20 blocks. A queen size measures 95" x 95" and is comprised of 25 blocks.

Technique: Foundation Paper Piecing

Finished Project Size: 12-3/8" x 12-3/8" (1 block)

Skill Level: Beginner

- Lots of dark and light strips of fabric that are 2" wide x varying lengths (precut prior to class)

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Jelly Roll Magic

Description:

Looks hard, but it's SO EASY! This beautiful quilt is so fun to make. Build your confidence in fabric choices and design, and enjoy perfect points every time!

Technique: EasyPiecing Grid for easy design and sewing

Finished Project Size: 78"x 78" Before

Skill Level: Beginner

Class Fee: \$75

Required Supplies:

Two jelly rolls cut into 2.5" squares or 1185 cut squares, with colors mixed evenly. As you know, every pre-cut 2.5" jelly roll is different as far as how many strips of each fabric are included. You need a roll that has at least 40 strips. Keep in mind how many colors or shades you want; some rolls have 4-5 different colors, where others may read as two colors! Make sure you've got a good variety of colors or contrast. If you want more specific fabrics buy extra yardage or add a third jelly roll. Another option is scraps! Cut into 2.5" squares.

- 1 ¾ yds Cut 340 squares 2.5" before class
- Basic sewing supplies
- 3 Elmer's Washable
- School Glue
- Applique pressing sheet (optional),
- Small Iron and pressing surface (there will be some to share)

Stocking Stuffers

Description:

Create a joyful Christmas quilt full of whimsical stockings using the Stocking Stuffers Block of the Month pattern and the Nutcracker Tradition fabric collection by Jennifer Long. In this 3-hour workshop, students will complete at least one stocking block while learning accurate piecing, strategies for managing long, narrow units, and tips for keeping directional prints aligned. We will also review layout choices, color planning, and simple embellishment ideas that students can add after class.

Technique: Accurate piecing, stitch-and-flip construction, managing long and narrow units, working with directional prints and stripes, block layout planning, and optional embellishment ideas

Together We Shine

with Karen Walker

Description:

Together We Shine is full of learning opportunity! Made up of 5 different blocks, 4 large and 1 small. In the morning when we are all fresh, we will begin with a larger star, learning the Hourglass Method using three different fabrics and how to trim for accuracy. Then it's time to take what we learned and create smaller hourglass blocks for the border stars. Once we confidently accomplish this technique, we will tackle easier blocks like the flag and bell. Throughout the 6-hour class, Karen will continue to share her tips on how to piece for accuracy. Tips to include pressing, trimming, using the sashing as a guide and how to successfully piece together the outer star border so 'Together We Shine' can hang proudly in your home.

Technique: Corner Triangle, also known as the Stitch and Flip Method. How to trim for accuracy. Hourglass Method and trimming for accuracy, Size Up, Trim Down for accuracy, Finger Pressing Method

Finished Project Size: 72" x 72"

Skill Level: Intermediate

Required Supplies:

- Pattern which will be emailed to each student ahead of time
- Small pair of scissors
- Seam ripper
- Straight pins
- Mechanical pencil for drawing diagonal lines OR Diagonal Seam tape
- 50 or 60 weight Thread
- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic rulers to include a 6" or 6-1/2" square with a 45 degree angle, optional 6" or 6-1/2" x 12"
- 6" or 6-1/2" x 24" rulers for trimming and cutting fabric yardage if needed.
- Small Iron and cutting mat, however each classroom will provide cutting mats and irons and ironing boards.
- Karen will provide each student with a travel size of Magic Quilting and Crafting Spray
- Any other tools you like to work with.

Fabric requirements:

I always suggest bringing a little extra in case there is a cutting mistake.

- Border Background: 2-3/4 Yards
- Light Blue: 1/4 Yard
- Medium Blue: 1/3 Yard
- Dark Blue: 1/2 Yard
- Gold for Bell Waist and Flag Post: 1/4 Yard
- Gold for Flagpole and Border Stars: 3/4 Yard
- Gold for Bell Sound Bow and Stars: 1/4 Yard
- Red Sashing and Border Stars: 1-1/4 Yard
- Cream for Flag Stripes: 1/8 Yard
- Red Flags, Cornerstones and Binding: 7/8 Yard



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Goodnight, Star

with Josephine Keasler

Description:

This quilt takes a smaller design called Starbaby to a larger quilt size of 96" x 96". It uses the strip piecing technique and is fast moving and is a great introductory pattern that can be used to learn basic paper piecing techniques required for many of the Judy Niemeyer lone star projects. The finished block measures 16" square.

Technique: Basic Paper Piecing

Finished Project Size: 96" x 96"

Skill Level: Intermediate

Class Fee: \$155

Required Supplies:

- 3.5 yards each of the black and white and 12 fabrics (3/8 yards of each per pattern)
- Optional Kit (pattern, fabrics and binding included) available with fabrics that match the quilt on the cover of the pattern and instructions.

General Supplies

- Rotary cutting mat – medium size
- Rotary ruler
- Rotary cutter and new (sharp) blades
- Fine Patchwork Pins (Prefer Clover 2507)
- Small scissors
- Seam ripper
- Sewing machine in good working order with a ¼-inch foot (without guard)
- Size 70 sharp sewing needles
- High quality cotton thread (poor quality thread will often break when removing the paper)

Paper Piecing Supplies

- 6 and 12-inch add-a-quarter ruler
 - Box of Jumbo Paper Clip
 - Color Sharpie (Not Black)
 - Scotch tape
 - Glue Stick (prefer UHU)
 - Flower pins – I usually prefer the thinner ones over the fatter ones. Choices-choices-choices!
- Some optional organizational supplies
- 7 Gallon size Ziplock bags
 - Purple Thang
 - Inexpensive binder to keep your pattern sheets (I keep mine in protective plastic sheets)
 - Note pad that you'll keep with your pattern and binder to make notes, write down questions you might have, and other important details that might help.

And there are lots of size options, so you can make the size project that works just right for you. Whatever size you choose, you are sure to have a finish that is absolutely stunning! So come, sign up, we are going to have a great time!

Technique: Stitch and Flip Corners and Nested Angled Seams

Finished Project Size: Offers 6 sizes. A baby size measures 37" x 37" and is comprised of 9 blocks. A child size measures 48" x 59" and is comprised of 20 blocks. A lap size measures 59" x 70" and is comprised of 30 blocks. A twin-size measures 70" x 92" and is comprised of 48 blocks. A picnic size measures 81" x 81" and is comprised of 49 blocks. A queen size measures 92" x 92" and is comprised of 64 blocks

Pumpkins & Fall Leaves Fabric Collage

Description:

What a perfect time to make a table runner or small wall hanging for the Fall. Combine a large pumpkin or a variety of pumpkins with a number of falling fall leaves. In this workshop we will work on a larger decorated pumpkin and cut a variety of leaves to be included in this project. This project will be completed and stitched at home.

Technique: Fabric Collage, Composition

Finished Project Size: Approx. 18" x 36"

Skill Level: Beginner

Class Fee: \$75

Required Supplies:

- Patterns provided in the workshop by the Instructor

-Fabrics: Fall colored fabrics suitable for leaves in a variety of oranges, browns, greens, yellow and red, small pieces approx. 6". A variety of oranges for the pumpkin from dark value, mediums and some light values. Flowers suitable for fussy cutting for details on the pumpkin like gaffe or other floral fabrics.

-Background approx. ½ yd in light or natural color. Can be chosen after workshop

-Approx ½ yd of Pellon 830 (Easy Pattern) interfacing or similar foundation

-Pencil, chalk pencil or similar fabric marking tools. Disappearing ink pen works. (I use the Bohin chalk pencil, red one)

-Scissors, sharp and good for cutting small pieces of fabric. I use KKB 6" perfect scissors.

-Fabric glue, I use Alennes Original Tacky Glue. Can be glue bottle with needle dispenser. Tool for applying glue like a toothpick or I have glue applicators for sale.

-Optional: Tweezers

-Optional: Battery powered Light box, like a phone charger/battery pack

Technique: Zipper Sewing, Pouch Assembly

Finished Project Size: 4 ½" (11.5cm) x 4" (10cm) x 3 ¼"(8cm)

Skill Level: Beginner

Required Supplies:

- Onigiry Pouch Pattern (available in my shop: Sewingillustration.com)
- Quilting cotton: Fat eighth (9"x22")(23cmx55cm) for exterior panel
- Quilting cotton: Fat sixteenth (9"x11")(23cm x 28 cm)
- Quilting cotton: Fat eighth for lining
- Single sided fusible foam stabilizer: Fat eighth, such a Basa; In-R-Foam or Pellon Flex Foam (or fusible batting or fusible web (such as Steam-A-Seam 2) + foam stabilizer)
- Zipper: 12"(30cm), #5 nylon (Rose Gold zipper is available in my shop) (https://sewingillustration.com/products/28-double-slide-zipper-4pcs-rose-gold?_pos=2&_psq=zipper%20r&_ss=e&_v=1.0)

- 3/8 yd of Fabric 3 (Large Squares)

Technique: Stitch and flip /snowball corners

Finished Project Size: Baby (41" x 42"). Throw (69" x 71"), and Bed (104" x 107")

Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Technique: Foundation Paper Piecing. No Waste Flying Geese Method. Scrappy Binding.

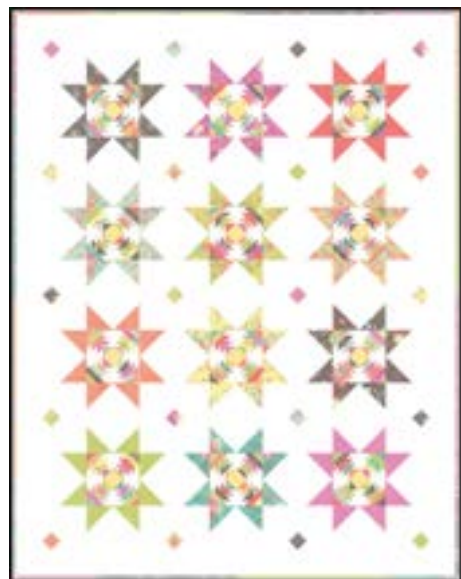

Technique: English Paper Piecing

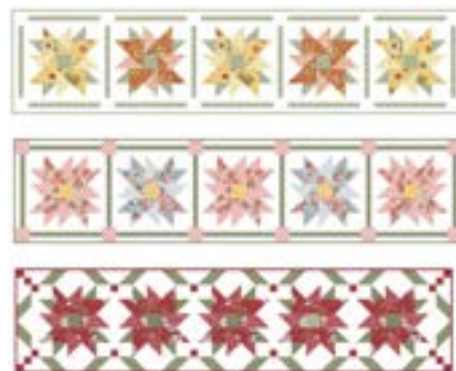

Technique: No Waste Flying Geese, Half Square Triangles, Square in a Square Units

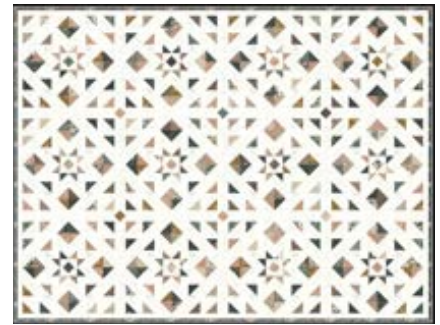

Blocks are created with a scrappy variety of caramels, taupe, creams and cornflower blues for a fabulous classic palette. Choose the lap quilt or simply the single block mini for a more immediate finish and watch your owl friends come to life.

Block is made with my signature SEW & FLIP method and comes together like a dream, one section at a time. We will cover all the hints and tips to make this block simple and straightforward to piece and assemble. Come join us and add Olivander into your autumnal decorating!

Pattern is included with the class. Optional kids will be available one month before the event to all class participants. Optional precutting sheet will be available one month before the event.

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Modern Autumn Prairie

with Laura Strickland

Description:

This is a great “next step” for a confident beginner quilter. A great base or a wonderful refresher to hone your piecing skills and be introduced to fusible raw-edge applique. This is a sampler quilt pattern constructed in rows. Each row features 1 block in multiple sizes (4”, 8”, 12” and 16”). In class, you will construct one of each block at the 16” size and one applique. This quilt is shown in a fall color palette and is featured in Riley Blake’s Whispering Hallows Halloween Batiks that debuted in the summer of 2026. However, it looks just as nice in many other colorways or genres of fabric. It is good for any occasion without the pumpkin appliques. Students will learn how to plan and construct a mixed-technique composition, focusing on precision piecing, seam direction, alignment, and shape continuity within FPP units, alongside appliqué preparation using freezer paper, starch, and glue-basting for clean, professional edges. Emphasis is placed on construction sequencing, layering order, and decision-making, helping students understand not just how to execute each technique, but when and why to use them together. This workshop centers on transferable skills and problem-solving strategies that empower students to confidently combine FPP and appliqué in future quilts and original designs. Students leave with a deeper technical understanding and a versatile framework for approaching mixed-technique quilting with intention and creativity.

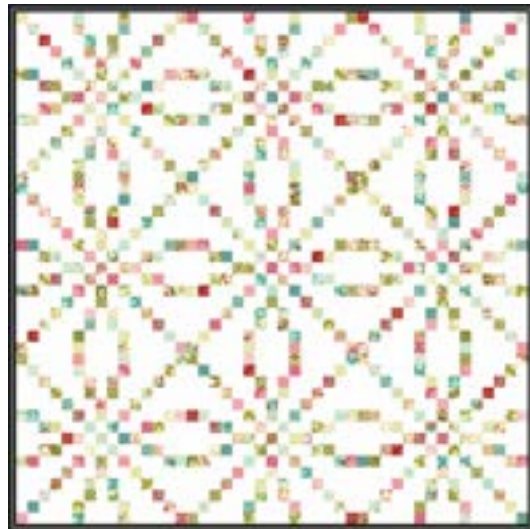
